The Middle Country Public Library received a \$35,000 grant from the Allstate Foundation, the charitable arm of the insurance giant.

The grant will support the library's Allstate Readiness Series, featuring a yearlong schedule of workshops focused on financial empowerment for women, particularly those affected by domestic violence, and safe teen driving.
